## Amenities of The Meadows' Permanent Facility

- 3,000 Slot Machines upon Opening with Space for 4,200 Slot Machines
- 2,750 Parking Spaces
- Three Restaurants, including a Premiere Steak House, a Specialty Restaurant which overlooks the Racetrack and a 200-seat Food Court
- Central Bar and Lounge and a Show Bar and Lounge
- Racebook/Teletheatre with Food & Beverage Concession
- VIP Boxes overlooking the Racetrack
- Outdoor Covered-Grandstand
- Bowling Center with 18 Lanes

- 3,000 slot machines on an approximately 100,000 SF gaming floor
- Approximately 4,100-space parking garage
- Four Restaurants, One Snack Bar and Three Bars/Lounges
- An Entertainment Venue

## Sands Bethworks

### Amenities of Sands' Licensed Facility

- 3,000 slot machines upon opening
- Approximately 4,700 parking spaces
- Nine Food Venues
- Approximately 200,000 SF of Retail Space
- 300 hotel rooms (3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2009)
- 125-acre development will also be home to the National Museum of Industrial History, an Arts and Cultural Center, and a 50,000 SF Multi-purpose Center

## Totals Jobs Created

**These four casino development projects will create (approximately):**

- **3,750** New Permanent Jobs
- **4,700** Construction-related Jobs

## Total Slot Machines in Operation

- With the opening of these four licensed facilities, there could be approximately **24,123** slot machines operating in Pennsylvania by July 2009.
