Introduction

The Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board ("PGCB") is pleased to present its fifth annual diversity report.

Pursuant to \$1212 of the Pennsylvania Race Horse Development and Gaming Act ("the Act"), the PGCB is charged with promoting and ensuring diversity in all aspects of legalized gaming. The PGCB developed rules and regulations, 58 Pa. Code \$481a, to accomplish its goals. The diversity regulations established the policies and procedures for promoting and ensuring that the regulated entities foster participation and diversity in all aspects of their operations in the Commonwealth.

This report provides an update regarding the PGCB's efforts to monitor the activities of its licensed gaming facilities ("Licensees") to ensure the Commonwealth's goals of enhanced representation of diverse groups in the gaming industry and the creation of quality living wage jobs for residents of this Commonwealth. Sections §13A04, 1325 and 1510 of the Act requires that Licensees maintain local preferences in their hiring practices.

Evidence of the Licensees' commitment to promoting diversity in their hiring of local residents as well as meeting the goals set forth in the statute relating to table-games employees is clear and convincing. As of June 30, 2012, the Licensees employed a total of 16,406 individuals. Residents of the Commonwealth comprise 89% of the Licensees' workforce. Approximately 42% of the employees are females while

29% of those employed at the licensed facilities are racial minorities. Additionally, the Licensees' Executive/Management/Professional staff consists of a total of 2,995 individuals. Of this total 64% are male, 36% are female and 23% are racial minorities.

Furthermore, the Licensees continue to work diligently to meet the goals of the legislature in the area of table-games employment. Pennsylvania residents currently comprise 80% of table games employees. Approximately one year remains to meet the statutory goal of 85% employment of Commonwealth residents by the end of the third year following commencement of table games activities at the licensed facilities.

The Diversity Committees established by the Licensees, consisting of executive level staff, continue to follow best practices while engaging in employee recruitment, training and retention related activities. The respective Committees have developed recruitment plans, employee referral programs, advertising plans with local media outlets, sponsored and hosted career workshops in the local communities to increase awareness, developed an internet presence, and built strong working relationships with local colleges and universities, workforce development and training organizations and local chambers of commerce. The Licensees have created employee-friendly cultures and policies as well as enriched communication methods/procedures to ensure the retention of talented employees.

Over the past year, the Licensees' Supplier Diversity programs have gained noteworthy momentum. During their infancy, many of the Licensees encountered challenges in their ability to advance goals of inclusiveness. In most instances, resources were allocated to start- up costs, outlays related to transitions from temporary to permanent facilities, substantial expenditures linked to the purchasing of slot machines, table games, and associated equipment and devices.

Unfortunately, no minority or women owned business enterprises manufacture slot machines. However, now that many of these challenges are no longer a hindrance, the Licensees are working meticulously to promote awareness and outreach among current and potential suppliers. These programs include, but are not limited to, purchasing upgraded systems that track supplier diversity performance, intense focus on second-tier subcontracting with minority and women's business enterprises as part of the process written into the prime supplier's contracts, strategic partnerships with local chambers of commerce, increased attendance at supplier fairs, hosting on-site vendor events, facilitating in-person meetings with suppliers, and mentoring small businesses. Expenditures for each licensed facility are available in the pages that follow.

Community outreach, sponsorships and donations to charitable causes continue to be a priority for the Licensees. Employees routinely volunteer thousands of hours to various organizations, fund raisers, neighborhood re-vitalization efforts, and educational pursuits throughout the Commonwealth. The Licensees have distributed approximately \$36 million towards philanthropic activities since 2006.

As always, the PGCB is sincerely committed to monitoring the activities of the Licensees in promoting diversity and ensuring compliance with the Act.

This report is made pursuant to \$1212(c) of the Act, which requires the PGCB to submit a report to the General Assembly summarizing the diversity related activities of each Licensee for the preceding year.






In addition to requirements in both the Gaming Act and the Board's regulatory policies and procedures, the PGCB requires each Licensee to execute a "Statement of Conditions" in which the Licensee agrees to submit an updated version of its diversity plan on an annual basis. As of June 30, 2012 PA casinos employed 16,406 individuals of which 14,527 (89%) are Pennsylvania residents. Additionally, Executive/Management/Professional staff consists of 2,995 individuals (Male 64%, Female 36%, Minorities 23%).




Hollywood Casino at Penn National Race Course
