**PETITION TO SURRENDER THE
PRINCIPAL LICENSE OF
EMILE JEAN RAYMOND GHISLAIN DE CARTIER DE MARCHIENNE**

The United States Playing Card Company (“USPC”), by and through its counsel, respectfully submits this Petition to Surrender the Principal License of Emile Jean Raymond Ghislain de Cartier de Marchienne and in support of this Petition, USPC states the following:

1. Emile Jean Raymond Ghislain de Cartier de Marchienne (hereinafter “Mr. de Marchienne”) currently holds a Principal License as a result of indirect ownership of shares in Cartamundi NV, parent company of USPC.
2. USPC currently holds a Manufacturer License pursuant to 4 Pa. C.S. § 1317.1, which was last renewed by the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board (the “Board”) on August 17, 2022.
3. It is believed and therefore averred that Mr. de Marchienne filed an application with the Board for licensure as a principal with USPC in August, 2019.
4. The principal license held by Mr. de Marchienne was approved by the Board for the period March 17, 2021 through March 16, 2026.
5. Effective September 10, 2024, Mr. de Marchienne is no longer a member of the Board of Directors of Brepols Group NV, 50% owner of Cartamundi NV, and no longer affiliated with USPC.

6. The departure from the Brepols Group NV Board of Directors by Mr. de Marchienne did not involve any misconduct or other wrongdoing.

7. Mr. de Marchienne no longer falls within the definition of *principal* under the Pennsylvania Race Horse Development and Gaming Act and the Board's regulations, and therefore, USPC submits this Petition requesting to surrender the Principal License of Mr. de Marchienne, without prejudice.

8. Mr. de Marchienne does not have any outstanding fees or other financial obligations that are owed to the Board.

WHEREFORE, The United States Playing Card Company respectfully requests that the Board accept the surrender of Emile Jean Raymond Ghislain de Cartier de Marchienne's Principal License without prejudice.
