ORDER

And now, this 24th day of January 2024, the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board (Board), having received the report of the Bureau of Licensing, finds that the key employees on the list attached hereto no longer require licensure as follows:

1. The key employees submitted an application and caused application fees to be submitted to the Board.

2. The key employees no longer requires licensure due to one of several routine reasons, including but not limited to resignation, termination, position elimination or death of the applicant.

3. Because licensure is no longer required, request for withdrawal has been submitted to the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board.

4. After review of the request for withdrawal, neither the Bureau of Licensing nor the Office of Enforcement Counsel objects to the withdrawal.

5. The Board has delegated authority to the Director of Licensing to grant routine withdrawal requests for key employee license applications provided the list of granted withdrawals is regularly presented to the Board for approval.

6. Pursuant to 4 Pa.C.S. § 1202(a), the Board has jurisdiction over every aspect of the authorization, operation and play of slot machines and table games in this Commonwealth.

IT IS ORDERED that the Board approves the withdrawal of the key employee applications for the applicants on the attached list submitted by the Bureau of Licensing.
