Meeting of the Board June 17, 2009 Minutes

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Kevin O'Toole, with the anticipated opening of the Rivers Casino in August 2009, read in to the record the following Resolution:

PGCB RESOLUTION NO. 2009-4 BGO – Delegation of Authority

WHEREAS Under 4 Pa.C.S. §1202(a)(1), the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board ("Board") has general

and sole regulatory authority over the conduct of gaming and related activities; and

WHEREAS Under 58 Pa.Code §467a.2(b), a Category 2 slot machine licensee may not commence slot

operations until a slot machine licensee successfully demonstrates to the Board that no less than nine criteria are met including, but not limited to, confirmation that the slot machines and associated equipment are properly operating; that adequate surveillance and security measures are in place; that the slot machine licensee's employees are all properly licensed, permitted or registered by the Board, as well as, properly trained; that all conditions of licensure have been

met; and that the slot machine licensee has successfully completed a test period; and

WHEREAS The Board has, in the past, delegated authority upon certain members of the Board, acting

collectively, to review whether all pre-opening criteria have been met and to grant

authorizations on behalf of the full Board when the required criteria have been met; and

WHEREAS The Board believes it is once again in the Board's best interest to delegate such authority to

certain members of the Board

RESOLVED That Board members Gregory Fajt, Sanford Rivers and Ken McCabe are delegated authority to

determine whether Holdings Acquisition Co., LP has demonstrated that all pre-opening criteria have been met and to authorize commencement of slot operations for the Rivers Casino. The Board members delegated this authority shall also have the authority to approve minor modifications of any gaming floor plan previously approved by the full Board between the date

of such Board approval and the commencement of slot operations.
