A quorum of the Board being present, Chairman Barasch called the meeting to order.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chairman Barasch announced that the Board held an Executive Session on August 14th to discuss personnel matters and to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relating to matters being considered by the Board on August 15. A brief Executive Session was held following the public hearing portion of the meeting agenda on August 15th.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Kevin O'Toole, Executive Director, informed the Board on the Casino Marketing and Capital Development Grant Program. He relayed that Act 42 created the Casino Marketing and Capital Development Account which is primarily funded by an assessment on gross terminal revenue against all operating casinos in Pennsylvania. He noted that each fiscal year, the Board is to distribute the monies accumulated in that account first to lower performing casinos and then to other casinos applying for grants if sufficient funding exists. The Act also requires the Board to establish procedures and guidelines for the distribution of funds and the grant program. Mr. O'Toole provided the Board with a document entitled "Casino Marketing and Capital Development Grant Program - Program Guidelines" which sets forth the mechanism by which the Board will administer the program beginning at some point early this Fall. He stated that this document does not issue distributions or grants, but instead announces the Board's intent as to how it will move forward in the near future.

Mr. O'Toole then updated the Board on the Petitions for **Interactive Gaming Certificates**. He stated that August 14th was the 120th day from the date we began accepting applications for Interactive Gaming Certificates and nine casinos have applied for all 3 types of certificates available. Mr. O'Toole stated that in addition, Presque Isle Downs has sought a table games and a slot machine Interactive Gaming Certificate and Mohegan Sun Pocono has petitioned for all 3 categories of games. As of August 15th, there are two (2) certificates for non-peer to peer tables games, two (2) certificates for non-peer to peer slot type games and three (3) certificates for peer to peer or poker games still available.

Mr. O'Toole then explained that after the initial 120 days, a **Qualified Gaming Entity**, which is defined in the Act as a gaming entity licensed in another jurisdiction, may file a petition with the Board for an Interactive Gaming Certificate in whatever categories of interactive games that are still available. See 4 Pa.C.S. §13B12(a.1)(3) and (6). The Act does not, however, define the process by which the Board is to proceed in selecting how such entities can apply for the available certificates.

Mr. O'Toole then commented that the PGCB will be announcing, at the September 12, 2018 Board meeting, the process of accepting and processing the applications for the available Interactive Gaming Certificates. The process will set forth who is qualified to petition for a certificate, what information the entity must submit to the Board in connection with a petition and the process by which the Board will select which entities will be eligible for vetting to receive a certificate if more petitions are filed than certificates are available.

In closing, Mr. O'Toole states that he anticipates that the period for submitting petitions from Qualified Gaming Entities will be October 15 through October 31, 2018. After October 31st, Board staff will begin the process of reviewing the submissions and determining which petitioners satisfy the criteria to be included within the group eligible to be chosen to participate in the selection process. Upon completion of that task, a selection of petitioners to be considered for a certificate will be provided at a future public meeting.
