PUBLIC HEARING HELD

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CHAIRMAN: At this point now, I'll turn to Doug Sherman.

ATTORNEY SHERMAN: Good afternoon, Chairman, Members of the Board.

Before the Board for your consideration is the Joint Petition of Sands Bethworks Gaming, LLC and PCI Gaming Authority for Approval of a Change of Control of a Category 2 Licensee brought under Section 1328 of the Gaming Act.

This is the matter that's been before you with voluminous filings in the document, and that you heard, I think for about two-and-a-half hours today.

The Board has, in advance of the meeting, in addition to the hearing, been complete - provided with a complete documentary and evidentiary record that's been submitted with the Office of Hearings and Appeals (OHA).

If the Board votes to approve the Change of Control, as requested, the Board also is required to establish a Change of Control Fee, as provided for in Section 1328D of the Act.

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And finally, as noted, the parties have filed a Petition seeking a designation of confidentiality of certain information submitted with the Petition and related filings.

Section 1206(f) of the Gaming Act provides for the designation and maintenance of confidentiality of certain information submitted by an applicant or licensee to include nonpublic background information, proprietary information, trade secrets, competitive marketing and strategy materials and security information.

The record is now closed and the matter is now appropriate for consideration of the Board on the joint motion to change control - the establishment of a Change of Control Fee and the designation of certain information as confidential.

CHAIRMAN: Thank you, Doug.

Are there any further questions or comments from the Board at this time?

Hearing none, is there a motion?

MS. MANDERINO: Mr. Chairman, I move

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the Board approve the Joint Petition for Change of Control with the conditions as outlined in the Board's Order, and that a $3.75 million Change in Control Fee be assessed in this transaction.

In addition, the Order authorizes the retitling of the Category 2 License in the name of Wind Creek Bethlehem, LLC upon the closing of the transaction. I ask that the Board consider the Order.
