Dear Mr. Sandusky:

Thank you for allowing Shuffle Master, Inc. ("Shuffle Master") the opportunity to comment on the Temporary Table Games Regulations adopted by the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board. After our review, we would like to provide the following comments:

CHAPTER 524. ELECTRONIC GAMING TABLES

- § 524.4. Electronic gaming tables.

Part (g) of this section stipulates that an electronic gaming table that is not a fully automated electronic gaming table shall be equipped with coin in, coin out, attendant paid jackpots, attendant paid cancelled credits, bill in, electronic gaming table paid progressive payout, attendant paid progressive payout and any other additional meters required by the technical standards adopted by the Board and published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* and posted on the Board's website.

Since there are no prohibitions in this section for electronic meters, can Shuffle Master assume electronic meters are permitted? If not, Shuffler Master respectfully requests a provision to accommodate for electronic meters. Electronic gaming tables utilize a database that records all information required by the meters list above. This database may be accessed at any time and the meter information required in this section may be produced for any given date or time period in the past 30 days of game play.
