And the property has certainly been a shining star in Fishtown and has done a great job at really taking the gaming environment and the entertainment to a new level in the area.

The building was built in an interim phase because of the great recession. And following our opening in 2010, we came and did a \$164 million expansion, where we added an event center, a parking garage, more restaurants and more gaming positions to the property. That has been very well received. We've done a great job.

We've followed since with our temporary Sportsbook, which opened up first in the Commonwealth, in Philadelphia, along with our sister property in Pittsburgh. We were very successful there. And the online gaming has now launched for the sports mobile betting with PlaySugarHouse.com.

So, the history of the property has been very well received.

At the same time Rush Street has really grown as a company and really grown the Rivers' brand. After we opened SugarHouse, we opened Rivers Casino in Des Plaines, which has been very successful. And we took the name from

We then won a casino license in 4 Upstate New York, and we continued to keep the 5 Rivers' brand alive and really started to grow it as a brand. And ownership felt it was time to take all the good stuff that has been happening in Philadelphia and bring Philadelphia into the fold of the Rivers' brand.

10 ATTORNEY COX: We'll turn it over to 11 Rob.

MR. LONG: So, we are rebranding to Rivers Casino Philadelphia. As you know, continuously, improving customer experiences is a shared goal of the PGCB and Rush Street.

As gaming now becomes a 360-degree experience, land-based, mobile and online, the unified brand for Rush Street's Pennsylvania properties will best serve the Commonwealth, most communities, our guests and our team members.

Our long-term plan is to establish continuity across Rush Street's Pennsylvania properties, Sportsbooks, iGaming and guest Rewards Programs. This rebranding represents a \$15 million reinvestment in the property, and all changes to the

facility will be completed by local companies and contractors.

The evolution of this rebranding will

appear - will rule out in phases, proactive

communications to our team, which will begin after

we return from the meeting here today. Then the

physical transformation of the property, signage,

logos, et cetera, redesign of gaming pieces, meaning

chips, cards and dice.

Additional consideration of select modification of Rivers Casino Pittsburgh brand to include the city designation, so as not to have the two confused, and updated internal controls pending PGCB review and approval.

The timeline for this is today we are announcing the intention to rebrand. In early summer the property transformation begins, including internal controls, gaming items and that sort of thing. In midsummer we planned a lunch. Igaming — by the end of summer will launch an expanded permanent Sportsbook that will be built this summer. And in — this fall we'll do the formal ceremonial Rivers Casino Philadelphia launch.
