A quorum of the Board being present, Chair Smyler called the meeting to order.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chair Smyler announced that the Board held an Executive Session on October 17th to discuss personnel matters, pending litigation and to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relating to matters coming before the Board on October 18th.

MINUTES/TRANSCRIPT

On a motion by Commissioner Hickernell, seconded by Commissioner Manzano-Díaz, the Board unanimously approved the minutes and transcripts of the July 26, 2023, meeting.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Executive Director, Kevin O'Toole, began his report by explaining several reasons why the month of October was significant for the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board ("PGCB" or "Board"). The first reason was October 1st is the target date for the issuance of two PGCB Reports. He also explained the PA's Gaming Act specifies the Legislature's very clear requirement that all parts of regulated gambling activity, pursuant to Title 4, should be transparent through the reporting of the annual performance of the casino industry and the general work of the PGCB.

The first report Kevin spoke about was the Board's Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 describes information from each of the seventeen land-based casinos in the Commonwealth and provides the revenue and tax figures for slot machines, table games, Sports Wagering activity and iGaming activity. He also states the report explains how the Board makes a concerted effort to be transparent in its work, on

behalf of the citizens of the Commonwealth. Mr. O'Toole said it was through the PGCB's Speakers Bureau where Board members and staff met with over two dozen community groups throughout the fiscal year, which helped to ensure the public had firsthand information on the oversight work of the agency and how gaming taxes from legalized gambling had a very positive affect on their communities.

The second PGCB report Kevin spoke about was the Annual Diversity Report, which was released several days prior to October 1st, and recounted the difficult adjustments for casinos that resulted from the COVID-19 pandemic. Despite those challenges, Kevin explained, the casinos remained committed to prioritizing the professional development of workers through mentorship programs and tuition reimbursement for continuing education. These training and retention efforts have consistently resulted in noteworthy internal promotions.

Kevin mentioned that October 2023 was also significant because it marked the 5th year of expanded gambling in Pennsylvania through interactive gaming, in the form of online slot games, online table games, live studio table games, online poker and sports wagering, both retail and online. He explained the Annual Report included detailed information on interactive gaming revenue and taxes collected as a result of interactive gaming activities, required by the statute.

Mr. O'Toole concluded his report by stating that interactive gaming revenue collected for slots, table games and poker for the month of September 2023 was in excess of \$159,000,000 – which was the largest amount of interactive gaming revenue generated in one month over the past 5 years.

OFFICE OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

Director of Budget, Dave Rhen gave his report, which included two items: board expenditures through the first quarter and an overview of the proposed budget request for Fiscal Year 2024-2025.

He stated that Board expenses for the first quarter of the Fiscal Year, or the period July through September, were \$10,736,523. Dave went on to explain that out of these expenditures, 93.6% or \$10,048,147 were for payroll while the remaining 6.4% or \$688,376 were for operating expenditures. He then stated that overall expenditures were \$369,595 or 3.6% higher than last year's expenditures through the first quarter, which includes a \$444,024 increase in personnel expenses and a decrease of \$74,429 in operating expenses. Mr. Rhen also noted that average payroll expenses for the quarter were \$100,245 higher, per payroll, than last year due to the increased number of employees. He further explained salary costs were \$5,898,260 or 58.7% of personnel costs, while benefit costs were \$4,133,273 or 41.1% of personnel costs. Also, Dave noted the largest operating costs included \$143,230 for subscriptions and database services, \$142,662 for real estate and parking leases, \$140,332 for interagency billings from the Office of Administration, and \$81,696 for annual license fees for document management and workflow software.

The next item Dave spoke about was the proposed budget request for the Fiscal Year 2024-2025. Dave explained the proposed requests were \$60,720,000 for administration, which included oversight of casinos, iGaming, and Sports Wagering. He also requested \$475,000 for Video Gaming Terminals administration and \$280,000 for Fantasy Contest operations. He explained the administrative request of \$60,720,000 included \$53,740,000 or 88% of the budget for Personnel expenses. Dave continued that the budget request included 20 new positions and 391 positions overall, which were primarily in the Office of

Enforcement Counsel, Sports Wagering, Operations, and the Gaming Lab. Also, he noted the budget included salary and benefit rate increases, consistent with union negotiated contracts, and at levels consistent with those used by agencies across the Commonwealth. Mr. Rhen also stated that there are

two scheduled union negotiated salary increases next fiscal year of 2% in July 2024 and 2.25% in January 2025. He also explained there are amounts budgeted for specialized items such as overtime, retirement leave payouts, shift differential and others are based on historical averages.

Dave Rhen then went on to explain the operating portion of the budget request was \$7,250,00 and included an increase of \$2,000,000 for the IT modernization project, which the Board recently commenced. Dave stated the IT modernization would improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the Board and streamline information gathering. He went on to say the remainder of the operating budget was primarily for real estate leases, investigative expenses, hardware and software licenses, and telecommunications and date costs, which Mr. Rhen stated are traditionally the cost drivers of the operating budget. Dave explained the proposed budget would be funded through a combination of \$7,100,000 in restricted revenue, which included application and licensing fees and charge backs of gaming lab costs to manufacturers. The funding would also come from \$53,620,000 in drawdowns from escrow accounts funded by casino operators, Mr. Rhen stated.

Next, Dave stated the Video Gaming Terminal or VGT budget is \$475,000 and the personnel component of this budget request if \$450,000. He further explained the operating portion is \$25,000 and will be utilized primarily for travel and investigative costs. He also noted this budget is equivalent to the current year's appropriation.

The last request Dave Rhen brought to the Board is the Fantasy Contest budget request which was \$280,000. He explained this request included \$270,000 for personnel and \$10,000 for operating expenses. Dave went on to say this budget was also equivalent to the current year's appropriation. Dave concluded his report by explaining the costs for both the VGT and fantasy contest budgets are billed back to the respective operators.
