The Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board (“PGCB”) is honored to present its seventeenth annual Diversity Report.

Pursuant to §1212 of the Pennsylvania Race Horse Development and Gaming Act (“Act”), the PGCB is charged with promoting and ensuring diversity and inclusiveness in all aspects of legalized gaming. The PGCB developed rules and regulations, 58 Pa. Code §481a, to achieve its objectives. The diversity regulations established policies and procedures for promoting and ensuring that the regulated entities support participation and equity in all segments of their operations in the Commonwealth.

This report provides an update regarding the PGCB’s ongoing efforts to oversee the initiatives of Pennsylvania’s licensed gaming facilities (“casinos”) to support the Commonwealth’s goals of enhanced representation of diverse groups in the gaming industry and the creation of quality living wage jobs for its residents. Sections 13A04, 1325, and 1510 of the Act require that casinos maintain local preferences in their hiring practices. As Pennsylvania’s gaming industry has evolved over the years, diversity and inclusiveness have remained at the forefront of the PGCB’s mission. Notwithstanding changes to the Act, casino ownership, casino executive management, or within the PGCB, diversity and inclusiveness have been and continue to be an ongoing noteworthy achievement of the entire industry.

Pennsylvania’s casinos continue to offer competitive compensation packages and growth opportunities to attract exceptional talent. As competition for talent has intensified, the casinos have developed and implemented strategies to recruit, hire, and retain employees. These strategies also embrace work-life balance, encourage communication, promote team collaboration, highlight innovation, and accentuate work-place flexibility. The casinos’ emphasis on talent development and retention has consistently resulted in significant internal advancements and has played a major role in the industry’s resilience and ongoing success. On June 30, 2024, the licensed casinos/resorts employed a total of 15,857 individuals. Residents of the Commonwealth comprised 90% of the casinos’ workforce. Approximately 42% of the employees were female while 41% of those employed at the casinos were racial minorities. Executive/Management/Professional Staff at the casinos consisted of 2,382 individuals. Of this total, 37% were female and 26% were racial minorities.

The Commonwealth’s casinos continue to create hiring and diversity plans which prioritize and support the career aspirations and professional development goals of individuals through networking events, mentorship programs, participation in industry conferences and seminars, team-building retreats, training camps and programs, tuition reimbursement for continuing education, peer-to-peer workshops, rotation of job responsibilities, job shadowing, recognition awards, succession planning, and more. In addition, the casinos have commendably achieved the Commonwealth’s goal regarding table games employment. Pennsylvania residents currently make up 85% of table games employees.

While many of the supply chain issues of the past several years have gradually been resolved, the casinos continue to navigate changing consumer needs, economic challenges, environmental uncertainties, geopolitical tensions, and resource limitations, as they institute new policies and technologies to support procurement operations and vendor opportunities. The casinos credit their steadfast commitment to diversity, adaptability, sustainability, and strategic insight for their resilience and accomplishments. As in previous years, the casinos continue to support organizations that promote supplier diversity and economic empowerment, such as the Minority Supplier Development Council, the Women’s Business Enterprise Center East, the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development, the Pennsylvania Department of General Services’ Bureau of Diversity, Inclusion & Small Business Opportunities, and regional Chambers of Commerce. Expenditures for each property are available in the pages that follow.

Community outreach, sponsorships, and contributions to charitable causes remain a priority for the casinos. Each year, casino employees and management enthusiastically volunteer thousands of hours of service to countless organizations, fund raisers, neighborhood revitalization efforts, and educational pursuits throughout the Commonwealth. Since 2006, the casinos have provided approximately \$213 million towards social responsibility causes and philanthropic undertakings.

The PGCB remains committed to monitoring the activities of the Commonwealth’s licensed casinos in promoting diversity and ensuring compliance with the Act.

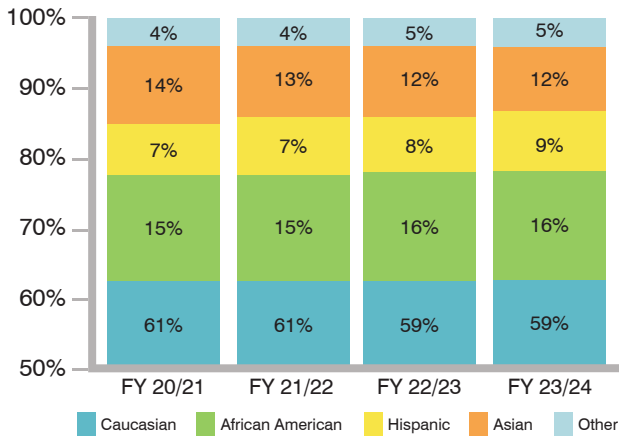

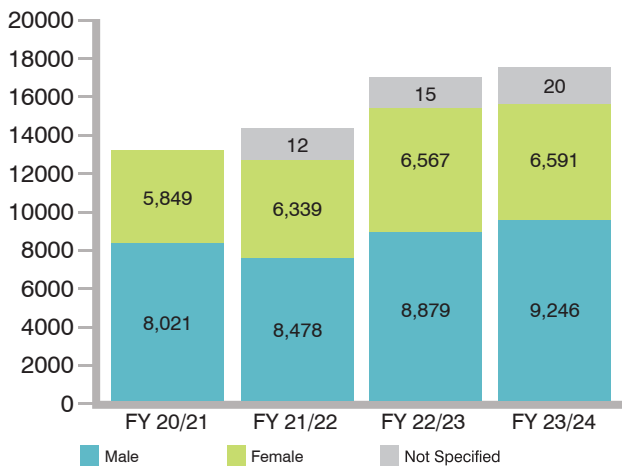

# Mohegan Pennsylvania



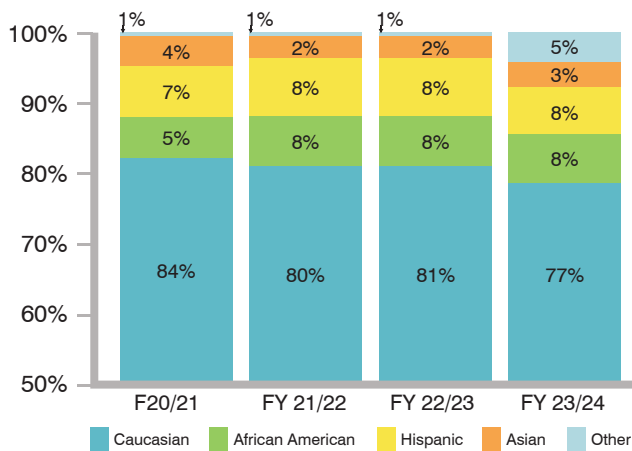
Mohegan Pennsylvania opened on November 14, 2006 in Luzerne County, Plains Township and is a harness racetrack.

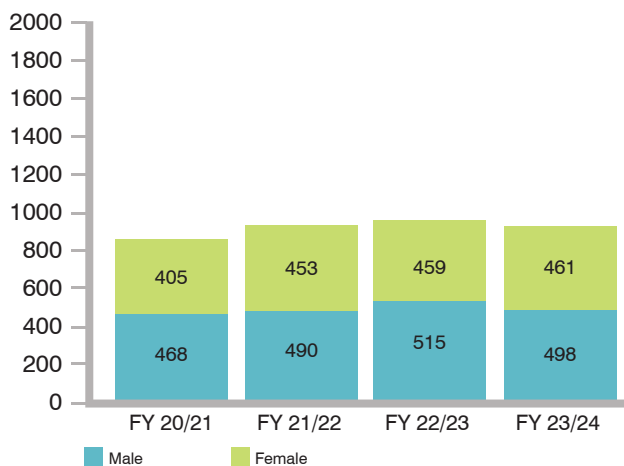

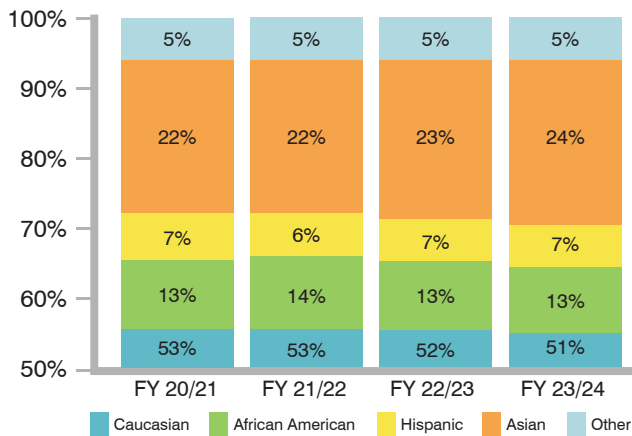
Parx Casino opened on December 19, 2006 in Bucks County, Bensalem Township and is a thoroughbred racetrack.

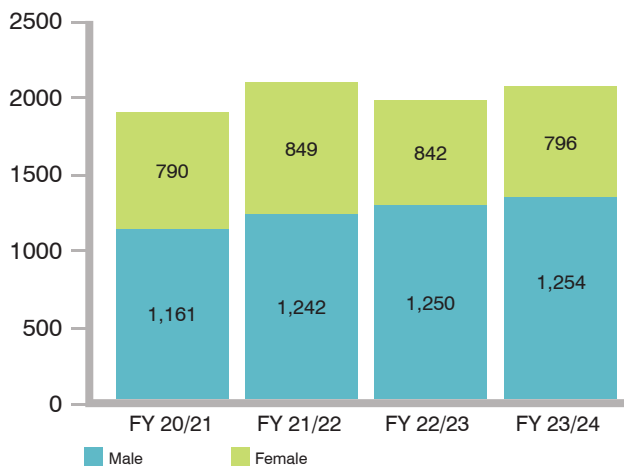

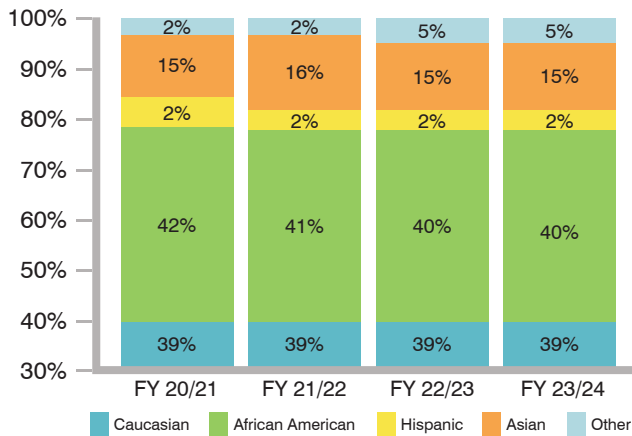
Harrah's Philadelphia Casino and Racetrack opened on January 23, 2007 in Delaware County in the City of Chester and is a harness racetrack.

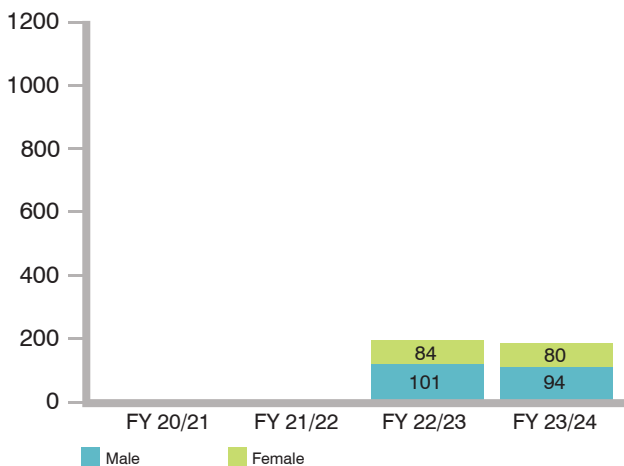
