A quorum of the Board being present, Chair Smyler called the meeting to order.

### **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Chair Smyler announced that the Board held an Executive Session on September 17<sup>th</sup> to discuss personnel matters, pending litigation and to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relating to matters coming before the Board on September 18<sup>th</sup>.

Chair Smyler also announced the Board has scheduled the Public Input Hearing, related to the license renewal application of Presque Isle Downs and Casino in Erie County. The hearing will be held Wednesday, September 25<sup>th</sup> beginning at 10:30 am, at the Summit Township Building, 1230 Town Hall Road West, Suite 100, Erie, PA 16509.

Chair Smyler additionally recognized Dan Stambaugh's retirement, effective October 4<sup>th</sup>. Chair Smyler further stated he served as the Board's legislative liaison, beginning on January 7, 2006, and within his 18+ year span, he worked with the General Assembly on 3 amendments to the Gaming Act, seen the Commonwealth grow in regard to casino gaming, was directly involved in all the substantial revenues the casinos have brought to the Commonwealth. Chair Smyler concluded her announcements by thanking Dan for his service and wished him well in his retirement.

### **MINUTES/TRANSCRIPT**

On a motion by Commissioner Dermody, seconded by Commissioner Dillon, the Board unanimously approved the minutes and transcripts of the June 26, 2024, meeting.

### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Executive Director Kevin O'Toole spoke of the continued growth of gaming revenue and the catalyst behind that growth. He also provided an update on responsible gaming self-imposed limits ("SILs").

Kevin stated since the start of this fiscal year, 2024-2025, both July and August each have generated over \$500 million in gaming revenue from all sources regulated by the Gaming Control Board. August's gaming revenue of approximately \$509 million was 11.6% higher than revenue generated in August of last year. He also stated that the catalyst for this growth is online gambling that simulate slot machines and table games along with online sports betting activity. Those three areas of gaming increased 29%, 18% and 38% respectively, from the previous year's figures.

Kevin said anytime we recognize the growth of online gaming, we need to be extra cognizant of problem gambling and we need to assess whether our and the industry's responsible gaming programs are effective. The Gaming Industry, through the American Gaming Association, has designated September as "Responsible Gaming Education Month" ("RGEM"). RGEM emphasizes and reinforces how technology can be used as an effective tool to provide players with opportunities to better control their gambling activity. Mr. O'Toole said that the Gaming Control Board regulations at Section 814a.2 offer players a number of responsible gaming SILs. These limits allow a player to control the amount of their deposits, the maximum amount per each wager, the maximum amount of funds they want to spend during their online gaming session, and a self-imposed cooling off period that must be a minimum of 72 hours but can be longer. The Board's Office of Compulsive and Problem Gambling, through Director Elizabeth Lanza, has been able to monitor the usage of these self-imposed limits monthly through the assistance of online gaming operators who provide the statistics for their registered player accounts. The most used limit that player's choose is the deposit limit, and the second most used limit is the self-suspension cool down period. Kevin stated that during the month of August 2024, the deposit limit was activated by players over 193,000 times and the self-suspension cool down period was activated over 105,000 times. Kevin went on to say that Director Lanza has been collecting these statistics for over a year now and it was encouraging to see that in August 2024 the percentage of players to use these self-imposed limits exceeded 4% of the total number of online gambling accounts.

Kevin concluded his report by saying that there are always challenges that must be met to minimize compulsive and problem gambling. These challenges are being met in Pennsylvania, in part, by the collaborate efforts of the Gaming Industry and the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board by utilizing operator's the technology to provide self-help options to players gambling online.
