**ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Chair Smyler announced that the Board held an Executive Session on October 22<sup>nd</sup> to discuss personnel matters, pending litigation and to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relating to matters coming before the Board on October 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**MINUTES/TRANSCRIPT**

On a motion by Commissioner Manzano-Díaz, seconded by Commissioner Hickernell, the Board unanimously approved the minutes and transcripts of the July 24, 2024, meeting.

On a motion by Commissioner Hickernell, seconded by Commissioner Dillon, the Board unanimously approved the minutes and transcripts of the August 21, 2024, meeting.

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Executive Director, Kevin O'Toole, gave a report on the Multi-State Internet Gaming Agreement. Kevin began by stating on October 10, 2024, Governor Josh Shapiro sent a letter requesting that the Board "begin the process of negotiating the Commonwealth's entrance into the Multi-State Internet Gaming Agreement." As the Board is aware, the Pennsylvania Race Horse Development and Gaming Act authorizes Pennsylvania to enter into a multi-state interactive gaming agreement with other states where iGaming is authorized, however the Governor of Pennsylvania must approve any such action on behalf of the Commonwealth. With Governor Shapiro's expressed desire, we can now pursue on-line interstate gaming.

In consultation with the Governor's staff, it was agreed that Pennsylvania will initially only pursue multi-state gaming for peer-to-peer poker games.

Presently, the Multi-State Interactive Gaming Agreement exists between New Jersey, Delaware, West Virginia, Michigan and Nevada. Pursuant to this agreement, operators licensed in two or more of those states can share patrons in the play of interstate on-line games. As will be the case with Pennsylvania, most of these states only allow operators to offer interstate peer-to-peer poker games. Pursuant to the agreement, tax revenues for the various jurisdictions are based upon the percentage of players from each state that are participating in any given game.

Kevin stated that history has shown that the increased customer base which goes along with adding jurisdictions – what is referred to as “shared liquidity” – has increased the number of poker games available for play at various buy-in price points and has, generally, helped the online gaming industry by creating more consumer interest in online poker.

The first step in joining the multi-state agreement is asking the other 5 states involved, representatives of which are members of the Multi-State Internet Gaming Association, to allow Pennsylvania to be admitted into the association and begin the process of entering the agreement. Upon receipt of a Notice of Admission, the Board will thereafter be presented with the multi-state agreement, which will be provided to Governor Shapiro for his signature.

Kevin asked for a motion to ratify Pennsylvania’s admission into the Multi-State Internet Gaming Association thereby starting the process of entering the Multi-State Internet Gaming Agreement.

**OFFICE OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT**

Director David Rhen presented two items to the Board – first, board expenditures through the first quarter, and second, an overview of the proposed budget request for FY 2025-26.

Dave state that Board expenses for the first quarter of the fiscal year thru September 30<sup>th</sup> were \$12,472,093. 90% or \$11,212,926 of these expenditures were for payroll while the remaining 10% or \$1,259,167 were for operating expenditures. Overall expenditures were \$1.7M higher versus the first quarter last year. This includes increases of \$1.2M for personnel and \$571,000 for operating expenses. Payroll expenses were higher due to salary increases and the expansion of the complement. Operating expenses increased due to IT modernization and timing differences. Payroll costs were \$6.6M for salaries and \$4.6M for benefits.

He also stated the largest operating costs included \$436,000 for services including consultants for IT modernization and interagency billings, \$414,000 for rentals and leases, and \$205,000 for subscriptions and other operating expenses.

Dave continued with his second item, the FY 25-26 budget request, which the proposed requests are \$61,587,000 for administration which includes oversight of casinos, iGaming, and Sports Wagering; \$489,000 for Video Gaming Terminals administration, and \$288,000 for Fantasy Contest operations.

The administrative request includes \$54,051,000 or 88% of the overall request for Personnel expenses. This includes 29 new positions and 408 positions overall, including staff for the anticipated opening of a new category 4 casino. The budget includes salary and benefit rate increases consistent with union negotiated contracts and at levels consistent with those used by agencies across the Commonwealth. There are two scheduled union negotiated salary increases next fiscal year of 2.25% in July 2025 and 2.25% in January 2026.

Amounts budgeted for specialized items such as overtime, retirement leave payouts, shift differential are based on historical averages.

He stated the operating portion of the budget request is \$7,100,000. This includes \$2,000,000 for the Board's continuing IT modernization project to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the Board and streamline information gathering. The remainder of the operating budget is primarily for real estate leases, investigative expenses, hardware and software licenses, and telecommunications and data costs. The traditional cost drivers of the operating budget.

The proposed budget would be funded through a combination of \$7,100,000 in restricted revenue, including application and license fees and charge backs of gaming lab costs to manufacturers; and \$54,487,000 in draw-downs from escrow accounts funded by casino operators.

The Video Gaming Terminal or VGT budget is \$489,000. The personnel component of this budget request is \$464,000 and the operating portion is \$25,000 and will be utilized primarily for travel and investigative costs.

Finally, he stated that the Fantasy Contest budget request is \$288,000. The request includes \$278,000 for personnel and \$10,000 for operating expenses. The costs for both the VGT and fantasy contest budgets are billed back to the respective operators.
