





RESPONSIBLE GAMING




- Responsible Gaming Committee meets at a minimum quarterly to discuss any ongoing concerns and revisions required in the Responsible Gaming plan.
- Team Member Training
 - Live! Casino educates all Team Members regarding compulsive and problem gambling, the prohibition of underage gambling, the prohibition of gambling by intoxicated patrons, and the identification and ejection of excluded and self-excluded people.
 - All Team Members must complete training conducted by the Council on Compulsive Gambling in Pennsylvania prior to their employment start date.
 - All Team Members complete annual re-retaining in responsible gaming.
 - Live! Casino has an annual Responsible Gaming Education Week in September in conjunction with the American Gaming Association.

BANNED ONE / BANNED ALL

- All jurisdictions have regulatory programs for Self-Excluded and State-Excluded. Casinos are required to not allow these people to gamble while excluded.
 - Live! Casino ensures any new exclusions are reviewed daily in our casino management system and their player accounts are flagged appropriately.
 - Live! Casino has taken a conservative approach to say if a patron is excluded in any of the jurisdictions where we currently have a property, they cannot gamble at any Live! Casino property. This includes i-gaming exclusions.
 - Facial recognition technology will be installed during Q4. Live! Casino Hotel Philadelphia will be the first property in the commonwealth with this technology. It has been proven to be affective at Live! Casino Hotel Maryland.
