The Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board (“PGCB”) is pleased to publish its eighteenth annual Diversity Report.

Pursuant to §1212 of the Pennsylvania Race Horse Development and Gaming Act (“Act”), the PGCB is charged with promoting and ensuring diversity in all aspects of legalized gaming. The PGCB developed rules and regulations, 58 Pa. Code §481a, to achieve its objectives. The diversity regulations established policies and procedures for promoting and ensuring that the licensed entities under the jurisdiction of the PGCB support participation and equity in all segments of their operations in the Commonwealth.

This report provides a yearly update regarding the PGCB’s ongoing initiatives to oversee the operations of Pennsylvania’s licensed gaming facilities (“casinos”) in alignment with the Commonwealth’s objectives of fostering enhanced representation of diverse groups within the gaming industry and generating beneficial employment opportunities for its residents. Sections 13A04, 1325, and 1510 of the Act require that casinos maintain local preferences in their hiring practices. Over the years, as Pennsylvania’s gaming industry has progressed, diversity has consistently been a cornerstone of the PGCB’s mission. Notwithstanding changes to the Act, casino ownership, casino executive management, or within the PGCB, diversity has remained a noteworthy part of the entire industry and its ongoing evolution.

Pennsylvania’s casinos are committed to attracting exceptional talent through competitive compensation packages combined with abundant opportunities for professional growth. These practices reinforce the significance of creating a positive employee experience as a foundation for business success. A key strategic approach within the industry involves promoting talent from within and providing structured support to employees as they transition into new roles. The casinos have an impressive track record of internal advancement opportunities for employees at all levels. This approach has shortened the hiring timeline, improved retention, boosted employee engagement, and contributed to the long-term success of the casinos.

On June 30, 2025, the licensed casinos/resorts employed a total of 15,840 individuals. Residents of the Commonwealth comprised 90% of the casinos’ workforce. Approximately 42% of the employees were female while 42% of those employed at the casinos were racial minorities. Executive/Management/Professional Staff at the casinos consisted of 2,584 individuals. Of this total, 38% were female and 28% were racial minorities. Additionally, the casinos have exceeded the Commonwealth’s goal for table games employment. Pennsylvania residents currently make up 86% of casino table games employees.

Despite persistent challenges posed by inflation and tariff uncertainty, the licensed gaming facilities’ procurement professionals have demonstrated meaningful resilience in welcoming new small and diverse businesses into their programs. Notably, the additions have enhanced performance and quality of operations, as well as optimized costs. Casinos continue to adapt to evolving consumer preferences, economic fluctuations, environmental uncertainties, international relations, and resource constraints. The licensed entities are committed to the development and implementation of novel policies and technologies that enhance their purchasing procedures and identify potential business collaborations. Casinos continue to demonstrate sustained support for organizations that advance supplier development and promote economic empowerment, such as the Minority Supplier Development Council, the Women’s Business Enterprise Center East, the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development, the Pennsylvania Department of General Services’ Bureau of Diversity, Inclusion & Small Business Opportunities, and regional Chambers of Commerce. Expenditures for each property are available on the pages that follow.

Community outreach, sponsorships, and contributions to charitable causes have been an unwavering priority for the licensed entities. The casinos support organizations that provide food and shelter to those in need, medical research and treatment, educational programs and training, scholarships, historical preservation projects, event sponsorships, matching gifts, disaster relief, and public safety. Each year, casino leadership and staff enthusiastically dedicate thousands of hours of service to community revitalization efforts and educational pursuits. Since 2006, the casinos have made substantial contributions surpassing \$226 million to corporate social responsibility causes and philanthropic endeavors.

The PGCB is committed to monitoring the activities of the Commonwealth’s licensed casinos in promoting diversity and ensuring compliance with the Act.

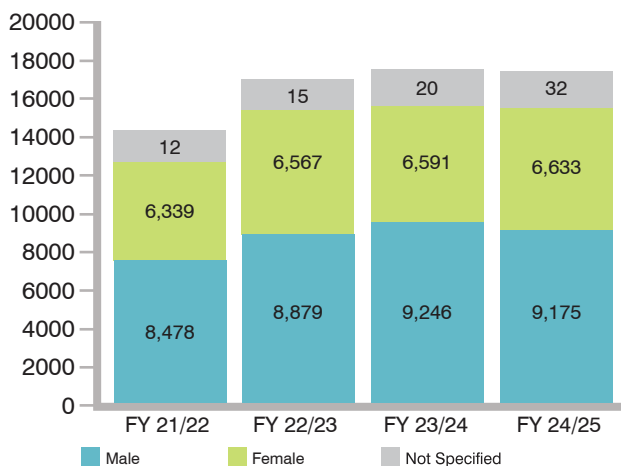

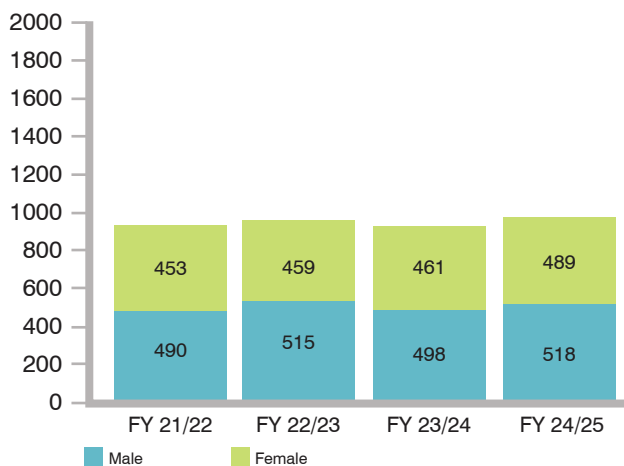

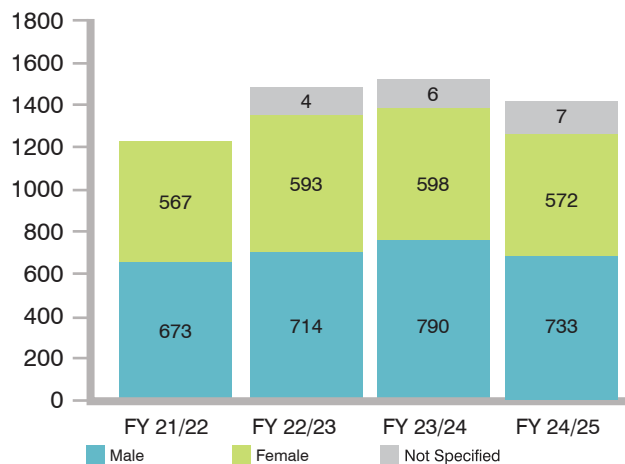

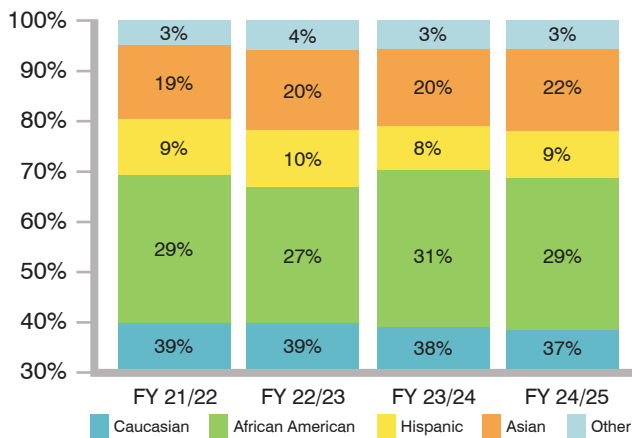

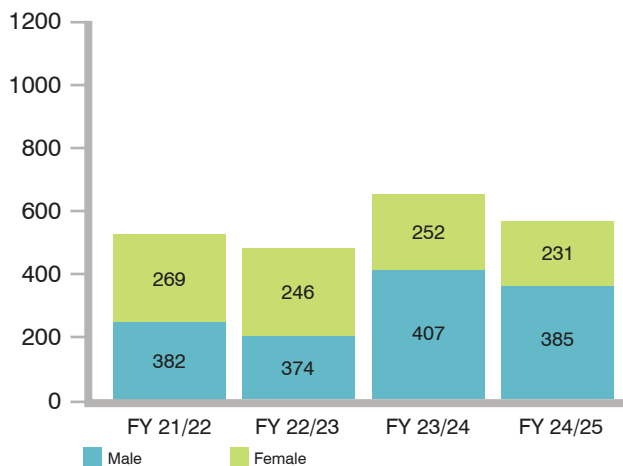

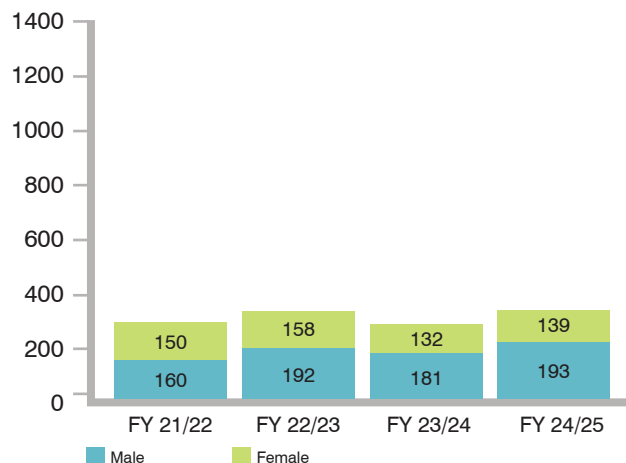

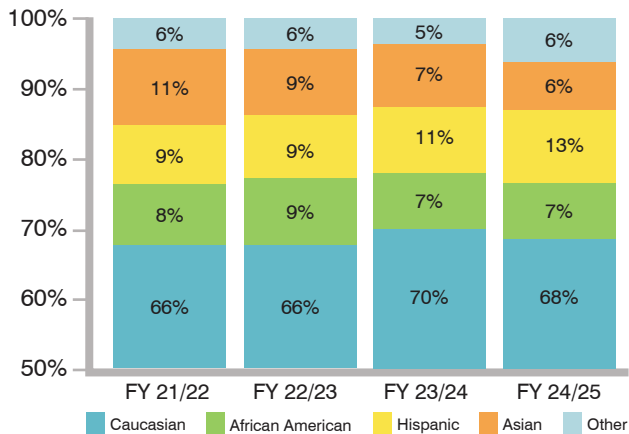

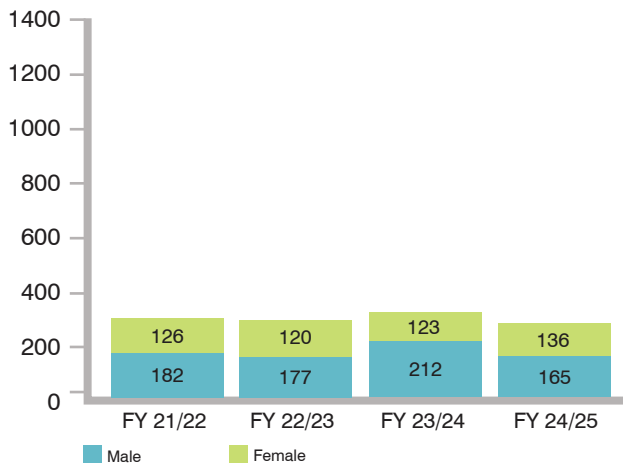

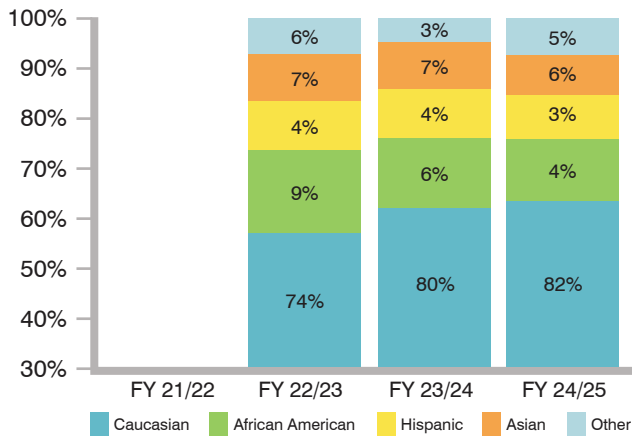

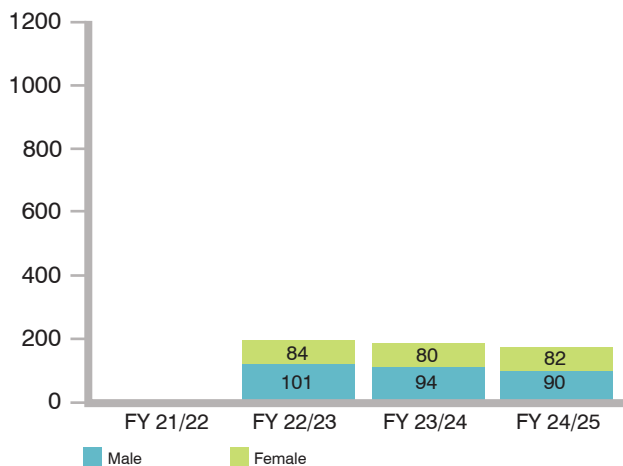
