Gaming Control Board Reports a Revenue Increase of 5.5% in September

HARRISBURG, PA: The Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board (PGCB) reported today that the combined total revenue generated from all forms of gaming, along with fantasy contests, during September 2025 was \$533,334,658, an increase of 5.43% compared to revenue generated in September 2024 of \$505,884,714.

Sources of gaming revenue regulated by the PGCB include slot machines, table games, internet gaming, sports wagering, fantasy contests and video gaming terminals (VGTs). The PGCB has posted separate reports for these types of gaming on its website, <https://gamingcontrolboard.pa.gov/>.

Total tax revenue generated collectively through all forms of gaming and fantasy contests was \$227,853,311* during September 2025.

The following chart compiles all revenue generated in September 2025 by casinos, along with fantasy contests and VGTs operated by other vendors and includes a comparison to total revenue generated in September 2024.

Retail Slot Machine Revenue

This September's revenue from the play of retail slot machines was \$191,490,486, a 2.78% decrease in revenue when compared to the \$196,959,217 generated in September 2024.

The number of slot machines in operation in September 2025 was 24,331 compared to 24,558 at the casinos in September 2024.

Retail Table games revenue for September 2025 was \$73,429,242, a decrease of 0.06% from September 2024 when revenue was \$73,474,836.

Internet Casino-Type Gaming (iGaming) Revenue

Casino games offered online generated monthly revenue totaling \$233,380,985 during September 2025 compared to \$176,700,937 in September 2024, an increase of 32.08%.

Sports Wagering Revenue

September 2025, total sports wagering handle was \$850,549,347 or 4.84% higher than September 2024 total of \$811,283,985.

At the same time, the taxable revenue figure for September 2025 was \$29,735,588, or 44.45% down when compared to September 2024, when taxable revenue was \$53,532,012.

Tax revenue generated from sports wagering during September 2025 was \$10,704,812*.

Video Gaming Terminals

Total adjusted revenue for September 2025 for video gaming terminals (VGTs) was \$3,341,931, or 0.60% lower than September 2024 when revenue was \$3,362,043. By the end of September 2025, all VGT Operators offered the maximum permitted five machines at 74 qualified truck stop establishments, compared to five machines at 72 establishments at this time last year.

About the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board

The Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board is tasked to oversee all aspects of gambling involving 17 land-based casinos, online casino games, retail and online sports wagering, and Video Gaming Terminals (VGTs) at qualified truck stops, along with the regulation of online fantasy sports contests.

The land-based casino industry in Pennsylvania consists of six racetrack (Category 1) casinos, five stand-alone (Category 2) casinos, two resort (Category 3) casinos and four mini-casinos (Category 4). A significant job generator in the Commonwealth, casinos and the other types of Board-regulated gaming generated \$2.8 billion in tax revenue in Fiscal Year 2024/25.
