Chair Smyler announced that the Board held an Executive Session on October 21st to discuss personnel matters, pending litigation, and to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relating to matters coming before the Board on October 22nd.

Chair Smyler announced that the Board has scheduled a Public Input Hearing relative to the license renewal application for Hollywood Casino York. The hearing will be held on Thursday, October 30th at 10:30 AM at the Township of Springettsbury Municipal Building at 1501 Mount Zion Road in York. The public is invited to attend the hearing and provide testimony; instructions on how to register can be found on the Board's website.

MINUTES/TRANSCRIPT

On a motion by Commissioner Dillon, seconded by Commissioner Dunbar, the Board unanimously approved the minutes and transcripts of the July 23, 2025 meeting.

OFFICE OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

Director of Budget, David Rhen, presented two items – first, board expenditures through the first quarter, and second, an overview of the proposed budget request for Fiscal Year 2026-27.

Dave began by stating that Board expenses for the first quarter of the fiscal year through September 30th were \$12,425,000, 94% or \$11,686,000 of these expenditures were for payroll while the remaining 6% or \$739,000 were for operating expenditures. He said that overall expenditures were down \$47,000 versus the first quarter of last year, due to fewer payrolls being processed and timing differences in processing invoices for operational expenses. Dave stated that payroll costs of \$11.7 million for the quarter included \$6.96 million for salaries and \$4.74 million for benefits, and that average bi-weekly payroll costs increased from \$1.9 million last year to \$2 million this year due to union negotiated salary increase and higher complement levels. Dave continued to say that the largest operating costs included \$286,000 for services including consultants for IT modernization and interagency billings, \$183,000 for rentals and leases, and \$104,000 for subscriptions and other operating expenses.

Director Rhen continued with his second item of his report on Fiscal Year 2026-27 budget request for the Board's consideration. He stated the proposed request of \$63,557,000 is for administration, which includes oversight of casinos, iGaming, and Sports Wagering; \$475,000 for Video Gaming Terminals administration, and \$280,000 for Fantasy Contest operations. Dave said that the administrative request also includes \$56,172,000 for Personnel expenses, which includes salary and benefit rate increases consistent with union negotiated contracts and at levels consistent with those used by agencies across the Commonwealth. He also stated that there are two scheduled union negotiated salary increases next fiscal year of 2.25% in July 2026 and 2.25% in January 2027. As well as amounts being budgeted for specialized items such as overtime, retirement leave payouts, shift differential are based on historical averages. Dave continued with stating that the operating portion of the budget request is \$7,85,000, which includes \$2,000,000 for the Board's continuing IT modernization project to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the Board and streamline information gathering. He then said that the remainder of the operating budget is primarily for real estate leases, investigative expenses, hardware and software licenses, and telecommunications and data costs. The traditional cost drivers of the operating budget.

Director Rhen said that the proposed budget would be funded through a combination of \$8,250,000 in restricted revenue, including application and license fees and charge backs of gaming lab costs to manufacturers; and \$55,307,000 in draw-downs from escrow accounts funded by casino operators. He also said that the Video Gaming Terminal or VGT budget is \$475,000, with the personnel component of this budget request being \$450,000 and the operating portion being \$25,000, which will be utilized primarily for travel and investigative costs. He continued with the Fantasy Contest budget request of \$280,000, which includes \$270,000 for personnel and \$10,000 for operating expenses. He noted that the costs for both the VGT and fantasy contest budgets are billed back to the respective operators.

Dave concluded his report requesting a motion to approve the Fiscal Year 2026-27 agency budget requests.
