A quorum of the Board being present, Chair Smyler called the meeting to order.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chair Smyler announced that the Board held an Executive Session on November 18th to discuss pending litigation and to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relating to matters coming before the Board on November 19th.

MINUTES/TRANSCRIPT

On a motion by Commissioner Dermody, seconded by Commissioner Huffman, the Board unanimously approved the minutes and transcripts of the August 20, 2025 meeting.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Executive Director, Kevin O'Toole, started his report by stating that the Office of Communications issued its press release regarding gaming revenue generated from all forms of gaming regulated by the Board for the month of October 2025. Total gaming revenue was just under \$597M, an increase of 20.22% over the aggregate revenue generated in October 2024. The impetus for the increase was Sports Wagering revenue, which increased to \$60.6M, an increase of 120% over October 2024's Sports Wagering revenue of \$27.3M.

In addition, iGaming Slot revenue and iGaming Table Game revenue increased significantly from the previous year. iGaming Slot revenue increased by 35% and iGaming Table Game revenue increased by 25%. He continued by stating that we also saw an increase of 1.43% in land-based casino slot revenue and an increase of 2.97% in land-based casino table game revenue. Kevin further noted that the total tax revenue generated collectively through all forms of gaming for October 2025 was \$252M.

Kevin added that anytime we recognize the growth of online gaming, we need to be extra cognizant of problem gambling and we need to assess whether our and the industry's responsible gaming programs are effective. He further noted that the Industry's and the Board's efforts to address problem gambling are effective. That through the tool of Self-Imposed Limits (SILs), patrons can place limits on the time they spend gambling, the amount of their deposits to their online gaming wallet, the amount of their wagers, and the amount of their overall spend.

Kevin concluded his report by stating that in collaboration with the Online Gaming Operators, the Board's Office of Compulsive and Problem Gambling maintains statistics on the use of these self-imposed limits. One of the most telling data points is the percentage of Pennsylvania online gaming accounts with limits set in any given month. Over the past six months, more than 5% of online gamblers in Pennsylvania have utilized one or more of the SIL tools described. This percentage equates to approximately 600,000 registered online players, demonstrating significant engagement with responsible gaming features.
