A quorum of the Board being present, Chair Smyler called the meeting to order.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chair Smyler announced that the Board held an Executive Session on July 22nd to discuss personnel matters, pending litigation and to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relating to matters coming before the Board on July 23rd.

Chair Smyler also announced that the Board has scheduled a Public Input Hearing relative to the license renewal application for Live! Philadelphia. The hearing will be held on Wednesday, August 13, 2025, at 10:30 AM at the State Office Building located at 801 Market Street in Philadelphia. More specifically, the hearing will be held on the 6th floor in the Betsy Ross Room. The public is invited to attend the hearing and provide testimony; instructions on how to register can be found on the Board's website.

MINUTES/TRANSCRIPT

On a motion by Commissioner Manzano-Díaz, seconded by Commissioner Dunbar, the Board unanimously approved the minutes and transcripts of the May 21, 2025 meeting.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Executive Director, Kevin O'Toole, started his report by updating the Board on the use of self-imposed limits ("SILs") by players in Pennsylvania who engage in online gaming for slot and table games. He emphasized that the Board announced regulations at the time that Interactive Gaming was first launched and are described clearly in the interactive gaming system in Pennsylvania which includes gaming self-limits.

Kevin continued by talking particularly about Board regulations at Section 814, which offer bettors several responsible gaming SILs. These limits allow a gambler to control the amount of their deposits to the online gaming accounts. Additionally, it allows the online player the ability to set a maximum amount per wager, to set a maximum amount of funds the player wants to spend during their online gaming sessions, and if necessary, the player can activate for themselves a cooling off period during which their online wagering account is deactivated from play. One requirement exists for the cooling off period, that requirement is that it must be imposed for a minimum of 72 hours – a 3-day period.

Kevin stated that board staff has been able to monitor the use of these SILs monthly through the assistance of the online gaming operators who provide the statistics from their registered player accounts. He said that the most used limit is the deposit limit, and the second most used limit is the self-suspension or cool-down period.

Executive Director O'Toole stated that the statistics show a significant increase in the use of those two player SILs between the months of March 2025 and May 2025. In March 2025, deposit limits were activated over 285,000 times. In May 2025, activations of deposit limits increased to over 367,000 times. Similarly, the self-suspension cool-down periods were used over 141,000 times in March 2025 and that increased to 157,000 in May 2025.

Kevin finished his report by stating that the substantiating statistic in the SIL discussion is that the percentage of PA online accounts that used SILs to help control their gambling activity. The utilization rate for SILs increased from 4.43% of PA online account holders in March 2025, to 5.54% of PA online account holders during May 2025. He said that SILs have, and continue to be, a valuable tool to players of interactive gaming in Pennsylvania by offering effective ways to manage their gaming activity in a responsible way.
