A quorum of the Board being present, Chair Smyler called the meeting to order.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chair Smyler announced that the Board held an Executive Session on August 19th to discuss personnel matters, pending litigation, and to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relating to matters coming before the Board on August 20th.

Chair Smyler also announced the impending departure of two commissioners. The Chair noted for the record that Commissioner Regan remains on the Board; however, it is likely this will be her final meeting, with her successor expected to be seated before the September 24th public meeting. The Chair expressed appreciation to Commissioner Regan for her years of excellent service to the Board.

Chair Smyler finished her announcements with the resignation of Commissioner Nedra Ralston, with this meeting being her last to pursue other career opportunities. The Chair highlighted Commissioner Ralston's 4-year tenure and her contributions to not only the Board, but in both public service and leadership services. The Chair expressed personal appreciation for Commissioner Ralston's unique and youthful perspective, which contributed to informed and rational Board decision-making, and wished her well in her future endeavors.

On a motion by Commissioner Manzano-Díaz, seconded by Commissioner Dillon, the Board unanimously approved the minutes and transcripts of the June 25, 2025 meeting.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Executive Director, Kevin O'Toole, started his report by stating that July 2025 continued the positive revenue increases this year when compared to July 2024, with revenue from all sources totaling over \$557 million dollars in July 2025, a total of 11.36% higher than revenue generated in July 2024.

Kevin continued by talking about the positive trend of revenue growth in online gaming activities with interactive slots, table games, poker, and Sports Wagering revenue totaling almost \$269 million, an increase over July 2024 of 26.28%.

Executive Director O'Toole stated that the total tax revenue generated collectively through all forms of gaming and fantasy sports contests regulated by the Board amounted to \$238,543,797 during July 2025.

Kevin ended his report by thanking Commissioner Nedra Ralston for her significant contribution to the Board over the past 4 and a half years.

OFFICE OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

Director of Financial Management, Dave Rhen, gave his 2024-2025 fiscal year fourth quarter budget report, which he stated concluded on June 30th, 2025. He explained that although the fiscal year had ended, they will continue to receive invoices which will cause expenditures to accumulate over the next several months. Because of this, he included anticipated expenditures in the figures that he reported.

For the fiscal year, expenditures totaled \$56.5 million against an appropriation of \$57.2 million, which gave PGCB an anticipated ending balance of approximately \$700 thousand. Overall, Dave explained, expenditures increased by \$4.6 million due to higher payroll costs and the IT modernization effort.

He further explained that 87% of the expenditures or \$49.4 million were for personnel, consisting of \$29.1 million for salaries, \$20.1 million for benefits, and \$200 thousand for retirement leave payouts. Benefits as a percentage of salaries were 69.2%. Personnel costs increased \$2.8 million, or 6% from the prior year, which Dave explained was due to the expansion of the complement and salary increases.

He also said expenditures in the operating category were \$7.1 million, which included \$3.5 million for services such as the IT modernization effort and interagency billings provided by Commonwealth agencies, \$1.7 million for rentals and leases, and \$1.3 million for other operating expenses, such as subscriptions for databases used in background investigations. These expenses increased by \$1 million from last year, due almost entirely to the IT modernization project.

Dave Rhen concluded his report by stating the Fiscal Year for 2025-2026's appropriation has been enacted for \$60,423,000.
