A quorum of the Board being present, Chair Smyler called the meeting to order.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chair Smyler announced that the Board held an Executive Session on February 3rd to discuss personnel matters, pending litigation, and to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relating to matters coming before the Board on February 4th.

Chair Smyler finished her announcements by recognizing the service of Commissioner Frank Dermody to the Board since his term has expired and this will be his last public meeting.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Executive Director, Kevin O'Toole, began his report by noting that the month of December 2025 concluded with continued positive growth in gaming revenue across all categories regulated by the Gaming Control Board. Total revenue generated during December 2025 exceeded \$616 million, representing a 15.76% increase compared to December 2024. Slot machine revenue at the Commonwealth's 17 land-based casinos declined by 7.54% year over year, while table game revenue experienced a modest increase of 0.28%. He added that it was important to note that December 2025 included five snow days, which likely impacted in-person gaming activity; accordingly, these revenue results are stronger than they may appear.

Executive Director O'Toole further noted that the total gaming tax revenue generated from all forms of gaming and fantasy sports contests during December 2025 amounted to \$255,804,498. For calendar year 2025, total gaming revenue reached nearly \$6.8 billion, while total gaming tax revenue approached \$3 billion. This marks the fifth consecutive year in which gaming revenue increased significantly over the prior year.

Executive Director O'Toole next addressed the sustained revenue growth among both land-based casinos and online gaming operations, continued enhanced funding for local municipalities and counties through the Local Share Assessment (LSA) program. In 2025, more than \$50 million in LSA grants were awarded to Pennsylvania municipalities and counties. Recent examples of projects supported through LSA funding include the purchase of new fire department equipment in Lebanon County; the replacement of a quick response service vehicle for the Buner Hill Fire Company in Swatara Township; and a grant awarded to the City of Greensburg in Westmoreland County to support repairs to the Robert A. Bell Parking Garage, a four-story facility providing more than 400 parking spaces. Additionally, in Westmoreland County, a \$275,000 allocation of LSA funds will be used to purchase a distribution truck for the County Food Bank.

Executive Director O'Toole concluded his report by noting that Pennsylvania's gaming industry continues to provide meaningful economic benefits beyond job creation and economic development. Through the LSA program, gaming tax revenue is reinvested locally and statewide to support public safety,

OFFICE OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

Director of Financial Management, David Rhen, started his report with an update for the first half of the fiscal year through December 31, 2025. He reported the board expenses for the first half of the fiscal year were \$26,495,775 and were made up of personnel expenses in the amount of \$23,644,850 along with \$2,850,925 in operating expenses. He continued by stating that compared to the prior year, personnel expenses increased by \$1.1M while operating expenses decreased by \$298,000 due to timing differences in processing invoices but overall expenses increased by \$819,000 or 3.2%.

Director Rhen continued that total payroll costs amounted to \$23.6M, including salary costs of \$14.1M and benefit costs of \$9.5M. The increase in personnel expenses is primarily attributed to an increased employee count and union-negotiated raises. Furthermore, the operating expenses through December totaled \$2.9M with the largest operating costs including IT consulting expenses and interagency billing services totaling \$1.3M, and rentals and leases totaling \$696,000. Other operating expenses including investigative database services and Directors' and Officers' insurance totaled \$580,000.

Director Rhen concluded his report by stating the expenditure trends for the first half of the fiscal year indicate alignment with expectations.
