Re: Gaming Floor Changes

Dear Mr. Keelon:

Pursuant to 58 Pa.Code §467a.1(c), licensees are required to file either a petition or written request with the Clerk of the Board when making changes to the gaming floor. Whether filing a petition or written request, please label all future floor plan submissions and all future petitions/written requests as "OP-X"— "OP" meaning "operation plan" and "X" designating the operation plan number. This labeling enables Board staff to keep accurate accounts of changes to a licensee's gaming floor.

According to our records, The Meadows' last floor plan change was marked as OP-4. As such, please mark your next petition or change request, and the coinciding floor plan, as OP-5. Subsequent petitions or written requests, and the coinciding floor plan, should be marked in ascending numerical order. Please also include a completed version of the attached checklist with all future petition or written request for changes to your facility's gaming floor. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
