RE: Games Global Turbo Multifire Roulette Waiver Request

Dear Mr. Roy:

On behalf of the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board ("Board" or "PGCB"), I have reviewed your waiver request and correspondence on behalf of Games Global USA Inc. ("Games Global"), in which Games Global is requesting a waiver relating to the payout odds enhancements for Lightning Roulette under 58 Pa. Code § 617c.3(g) (relating to Lightning Roulette possible payout odds) to accommodate its Turbo Multifire Roulette game's configuration.

Games Global represents that Turbo Multifire Roulette operates consistent with Lightning Roulette (58 Pa. Code § 617c.3) except that Turbo Multifire Roulette includes 449 to 1 as a potential Lucky Number increased payout.

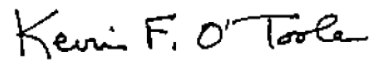
At this time, I grant Games Global's waiver request to offer Turbo Multifire Roulette as a variation of Lightning Roulette. Turbo Multifire Roulette is authorized to use the following possible payouts in place of those provided in 58 Pa Code § 617c.3(g):

Possible Payouts
499 to 1
449 to 1
399 to 1
349 to 1
299 to 1
249 to 1
199 to 1
149 to 1
99 to 1
49 to 1

The remaining aspects of Turbo Multifire Roulette shall follow the rules and procedures governing play of Lightning Roulette, as provided in 58 Pa. Code §§ 617c.3 (relating to Lightning Roulette) and 617b.6(b) (relating to Lightning Roulette—additional allowances for single or double zero wheel).

The waiver issued pursuant to this letter shall expire at such time that regulations are adopted by the Board and published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. If you have any questions, please contact Robert Wood, Senior Counsel, via email at [REDACTED].
