RE: Blackjack Three Card Poker (a.k.a. 21+3) Side Wager Waiver Request

Dear Mr. Tomashpolskyy:

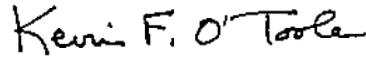
On behalf of the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board ("Board"), I have reviewed your, correspondence regarding Onseo New Jersey LLC's ("Onseo") regulatory waiver request regarding the Three Card Poker (a.k.a 21+3) blackjack side wager. Onseo seeks a waiver relative to the Three Card Poker side wager authorized under 58 Pa. Code § 633a.6(e)(9) (relating to Blackjack wagers) and its associated payable under § 633a.13(k) (relating to Blackjack Payout odds). Onseo requests permission to offer the following payable configuration for its optional 21+3 blackjack side wager:

Hand	Payout
Suited three-of-a-kind	100 to 1
Straight flush	40 to 1
Three-of-a-kind	25 to 1
Straight	10 to 1
Flush	5 to 1

Upon review, the Board believes that Onseo's proposed payable does not represent lower Return to Player ("RTP") percentage as compared to the payable authorized under 58 Pa. Code § 633a.13(k). Therefore, at this time I grant Onseo's 21+3 side wager waiver request relative to 58 Pa. Code § 633a.13(k) to allow for the above payable to be utilized. All other aspects of Onseo's 21+3 side wager shall follow the rules and procedures of the Three Card Poker wager, as provided under § 633a. Blackjack.

The waiver issued pursuant to this letter shall expire at such time that regulations are adopted by the Board and published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. If you have any questions or concerns on this matter, please do not hesitate to contact Senior Counsel, Robert Wood, via email at [REDACTED].
