RE: Additional Three Card Poker Progressive Wager Paytables

Dear Mr. Casole:

On behalf of the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board ("Board"), I have reviewed your correspondence of August 10, 2022, on behalf of SG Gaming, Inc. regarding a request to approve additional paytables for the purpose of using a Multi-Game Link system on the 5 Card Bonus Progressive wager. Specifically, it is requested that the three additional paytables be approved to allow the Three Card Poker 5 Card Bonus wager to be linked with other progressive wagers at gaming tables offering Crazy 4 Poker, Caribbean Stud, Four Card Poker, Let it Ride Poker, Texas Hold 'Em, Mississippi Stud, and Ultimate Texas Hold 'Em.

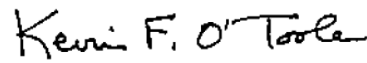
At this time, I am granting a temporary waiver that will permit the implementation of the requested paytables, permitting SG Gaming to offer the additional Three Card Poker 5 Card Bonus Progressive wager paytables. This will additionally allow table game certificate holders to link the Three Card Poker progressive wager with progressive wagers at tables offering the games listed above. The approved paytables are as follows:

Any Rules Submissions forms must be updated with the Bureau of Gaming Operations, and any applicable internal controls must also be updated. The Bureau of Gaming Laboratory Operations will also be preparing an approval letter for my signature, which the Office of Chief Counsel will use to draft Temporary Regulations. Once the Temporary Regulations are adopted by the Board and published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, this waiver will expire.
