RE: Spin A Win

Dear Mr. Yancey:

On behalf of the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board ("Board"), I have reviewed your correspondence regarding Playtech's request to offer its game entitled Spin A Win. Upon review, Playtech's Spin A Win game is consistent with the Big Six Wheel game provided for in Chapter 619a. of the Board's regulations, with Spin A Win containing variations to symbols, occurrence of those symbols, payout odds, and certain wagers and procedures as compared to those currently approved as part of the Board's regulations. Specifically, Board regulation provides that the Big Six Wheel shall include the following symbols, their respective counts, and odds:

Symbol	Symbol Count	Payout Odds
Flag	1	45 to 1
\$1	23	1 to 1
\$2	15	2 to 1
\$5	8	5 to 1
\$10	4	10 to 1
\$20	2	20 to 1
Joker	1	45 to 1

Playtech has requested that the following variations on symbols, symbol counts, and payout odds be granted authorization for use with the Spin A Win game in Pennsylvania:

Symbol	Symbol Count	Payout Odds
\$1	23	1 to 1
\$2	15	2 to 1
\$5	7	5 to 1
\$10	4	10 to 1
\$20	2	20 to 1
\$40	1	40 to 1
Multiplier x2	1	25 to 1
Multiplier x7	1	25 to 1

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Additionally, Playtech's waiver requests allowances for additional wager options. Specifically, Playtech seeks to offer two additional wagers, in which a player can wager on Odd which shall win if the wheel lands on a wedge with an odd number, of Even which shall win if the wheel lands on a wedge with an even number. Additionally, Playtech's Spin A Win provides for the possibility of increased payouts (without additional wagers) for wagers placed on \$1 - \$40. In the event of a multiplier wedge being spun, the wheel will be re-spun to determine a winning value of \$1 - \$40. Once this is determined, the winning value's payout odds will be multiplied by all preceding multiplier values and paid accordingly. For example, an initial spin which lands on x2 multiplier, then the x7 multiplier, then the x2 multiplier, then the \$1 would pay 28 to 1. Wager placed on the Multiplier wedges of the wheel are not subject to this increase and will only be paid at odds of 25 to 1. The payout odds for Odd, Even, and Multiplied wagers are as follows:

Wager	Payout Odds
Odd	3 to 4
Even	5 to 4
Multiplier Wedge plus subsequent spins	Multiplier x each additional multipliers spun x odds of non-multiplier symbol

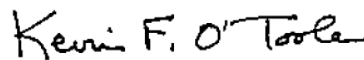
After review, it is our view that the modifications requested by Playtech do not negatively impact the integrity of gaming, as the proposed symbol variations and payout odds provide for higher return-to-player ("RTP") percentages and payouts for players who choose to place Big Six Wheel wagers.

At this time, I approve the requested variations outlined above, and permit Playtech to offer its Spin A Win game as a variation of the Big Six Wheel game with the characteristics outlined.

Specifically, Playtech is granted a waiver of 58 Pa. Code § 619a.3 (relating to Big Six Wheel payout odds) to allow for the above approved payout odds. Additionally, Playtech is granted a limited waiver of 58 Pa. Code § 619a.1(a), § 619a.1(b), and § 619a.1(g)(2)(i) (relating to Big Six Wheel layout and physical characteristics) to allow for the symbol variations outlined above. The limited waiver of these sections is only a reprieve from strict reading of these regulatory provisions, which contain specific symbols and layouts requirements relative to those symbols. Playtech will still be required to offer the above outlined symbol variations as consistent as possible with § 619a.1, and subject to approval under § 601a.10 (relating to approval of Table Game layouts, signage and equipment).

All other provisions of the Spin A Win game must operate in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 619a unless additional regulatory waivers are or have been requested and granted. The waivers issued pursuant to this letter shall expire at such time that regulations are adopted by the Board and published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*.
